

Gimme Back My Bullets

“Gimme Back My Bullets” is a two-man, handicapped, scramble tournament with an element of sabotage. There will be two 2-man teams in each group, and both teams can use “bullets” to sabotage the other team’s score. The “bullets” are as follows:

“First”: If the first player hits a poor shot, you can make the team use it without the other player getting a chance to hit. You must declare “First” before the second player hits.

“Worst”: You can force the other team to use the worst shot of their two. If a putt is holed, the hole is over and you can no longer declare “Worst”.

“Prove it”: If the other team hits a good shot (sinks a long putt, etc), you can make them “prove it”, negating the first shot and forcing them to hit again from the same spot. If the team successfully “proves” a shot that went into the hole, making the shot twice entitles them to one less stroke on their score...so use this one wisely!

Each team can use each of these bullets no more than twice during the 18 holes.

All other normal HMGA rules apply.

Points awarded:

Winners – 100 points each

2nd - 50 points each

3rd – 25 points each

Participant – 10 points
