

HMGA Championship

The HMGA Championship is the final event towards the HMGA points race and season pot. The HMGA Championship itself is an individual, handicapped, 36-hole stroke play tournament. Tees are based on handicap and/or age as follows:

Over 65 years old: May choose Red or Gold, hcp adjusts accordingly

Under 65, Hcp 10+: White

Under 65, Hcp 0-10: Blue

Under 65, Hcp under 0 & anyone competing for Low Gross: Black

Points are accumulated throughout the course of the season, and a player's ranking in the points list determines their starting position for the HMGA Championship. Starting positions will be as follows:

1 st : 99	2 nd : 88	3 rd : 77	4 th : 66	5 th : 55
6 th : 44	7 th : 33	8 th : 22	All others: 11	

At the conclusion of 36 holes, participants are awarded points for their performance. The points earned will be as follows:

1 st : 100	2 nd : 90	3 rd : 80	4 th : 70	5 th : 60
6 th : 50	7 th : 40	8 th : 30	9 th : 20	All others: 10

The winners of the season pot will be the top 3 places after starting position and tournament points are combined. Payouts for the season pot will be:

1st: 50% (Also the HMGA Player of the Year)
2nd: 30%
3rd: 20%

The player who achieves the Low Gross for this tournament will be the HMGA Championship winner and have their name displayed on the HMGA Championship plaque.

All other normal HMGA rules apply.
