

Match Play Tournament

The HMGA Match Play Tournament will consist of two parts: pool play and an elimination tournament. All matches are handicapped.

Pool Play (Day 1): A group of 4 (players A,B,C and D) will play 27 holes together. A&B will play a match against each other, as will C&D, during the first 9 holes. A&C will play a match, as will B&D, during the next 9 holes. In the final 9 holes, A&D will play a match, as will B&C. A won match is worth 2 points, a halve is worth 1 point, a loss is worth 0 points.

Upon completion of pool play, the top 16 players by points will be slotted into a tournament bracket. In the event of ties around the 16 player mark, a chipping contest will determine who makes the field for tournament play.

Tournament Play (Day 2): Players play their matches in 9-hole increments. The bracket is single elimination. 8 players will remain after 9 holes, 4 will remain after 18 holes, 2 will remain after 27 holes, and the winner will be left standing after 36 holes. In the event of a tie in a match after 9 holes have been played, the winner will be chosen via scorecard playoff. In the rare event that a scorecard playoff cannot determine a winner, there will be a chip-off to determine who moves on.

Points awarded:

Winner – 200 points

2nd - 100 points

3rd – 50 points

4th-16th – 30 points

All other participants – 10 points

Payouts:

Winner – 50% of pot

2nd – 30% of pot

3rd – 10% of pot

Remaining 10% goes to season pot
