

# Memorial Cup

The Memorial Cup is a Ryder Cup-style event in which two teams compete in matches over a three-day period. Two Captains will be chosen, and those Captains will select players for their respective teams. Once teams are set, the Captains will choose players to compete in 4-ball matches (days 1&2) and individual matches (day 3). Each match is worth 1 point, and at the end of the event the team with the most points will be crowned the victor.

Most matches in this event are handicapped. The exception is the “scratch match(es)” where players who are considered “scratch” will play against each other without handicaps.

At the conclusion of each day’s final match, the Captains will choose the matches for the following day. Players are welcome to attend the selection ceremony. The following day’s matches will be communicated via email and text as soon as they are official.

Traditionally there is an HMGA sponsored dinner the evening of day 2. Players are encouraged to attend and enjoy the camaraderie with their teammates and competitors.

This event is in memory of those HMGA members who have passed on before us.

Points awarded:

Match won – 30 points

Match lost – 10 points

Member of winning team – 10 points
